# Local Families Are Hit By The Child Care Crisis

## **Key Concerns**

#### • Childcare is too expensive

- o Average childcare tuition is <u>higher than the cost of attending LCC</u> imagine having two or more kids that need childcare!
- o Many families are *giving up work* or making other long-term financially impacting decisions based on the high cost of childcare

### • Childcare availability is too low

- o Most Cowlitz County families are <u>relying on Friends, Family, and Neighbors</u> <u>multiple days a week to fill the gap</u>
- Childcare hours outside of the basic 8am-5pm workday are <u>extremely difficult</u> to find
- o <u>Children with specific needs</u> are harder to find childcare for and keep access to childcare

We need <u>more local leaders</u> that will stand-up for our children and their families who are struggling with the high cost and low availability of childcare!

As a community we are joining together in calling for action that will help local families.

# **Actions To Improve Childcare Affordability & Access**

- Local employers can offer a <u>childcare benefit</u> that helps people with young children chose to stay in the workforce
- Our community needs funding for a service that helps <u>people start new home-based</u> <u>childcare businesses</u> (Vancouver, WA has successfully launched a program like this)
- We need to provide <u>more support to the Friends, Family, and Neighbor childcare providers</u> so many local families are relying on

### Tell people about the impact of the Child Care Crisis
